1. MISSION

1: The Mission of the United States Naval Air Base, Navy No. 3247, is to maintain and operate a base for naval aircraft units, providing facilities for operation and maintenance of aircraft, supplying aircraft units with such material as they may properly require, and providing berthing, messing and recreational facilities for aviation personnel, in order to enable fleet aircraft to operate efficiently in the performance of their tasks.

2. CHAIN OF COMMAND

1: The Air Base Commander of the Naval Air Base shall have command over such Construction Battalion Maintenance Units, Combat Aircraft Service Units or other units as may be assigned. The Air Base Commander will report direct to the Commanding General, Island Command for Operation and through the Island Command to Commander Air Force Pacific Fleet for Administration. In special cases reports are also made to Commander Forward Area, Central Pacific, and/or to Commander Service Force, Pacific, depending on the particular circumstances.

2: The relations of aircraft and other fleet units at the base to the Air Base Commander are governed by the principles enunciated in Articles 1554 through 1559 of U. S. Navy Regulations. The Fleet Air Detachments and other units based here will accordingly supply to the base the
