Subj: Report on IFF Bogeys.

1. It is requested that Base Operations submit a complete report on all aircraft reported to have faulty IFF--(Bogey). Such reports will facilitate checking the gear in the aircraft and thus assist in overcoming the IPF problem.
2. Such a memo, to be most effective, should contain the following information:
  - (1) Aircraft number and squadron.
  - (2) Call sign.
  - (3) Time-date group of bogey report.
  - (4) Unit by whom bogey report is made.
3. It is requested that all such reports be turned in to Lieutenant (jg) John Dow, Radio Division, CASU-44, as soon as possible after Base Operations is notified of aircraft with faulty IFF.
