NARRATIVE

Additional facilities recently completed include an engine change hangar. This hangar, constructed of salvaged Japanese metal, will accommodate four aircraft at one time and is of great value due to frequent rains which seriously hampered the engine change program when work had to be done in the open.

For calibrating aircraft compasses on the ground a Compass Rose was constructed with a turntable in the center and a portable dolly for the nose wheel. Other recently installed equipment includes two B-2 Field Test Stands, Airco Model, Type 202 (F-4) Propeller Governor Test Stand.

Due to increased work load the facilities of the Radio-Radar Division were enlarged. The chief additions were a 16' x 50' structure for additional radar shop space, and appropriate equipment to service PB4Y-2 gear.
