The new executive officer of CASU(F)-44, Lieut. Marshall M. H. DANA, S(A), USNR, 253985, was born in Cincinnati, Ohio, 17 February 1908. He attended Milton Academy in Milton, Mass., and the Hunn School at Princeton, New Jersey. He graduated from Princeton University in 1932 with a BS in Geology.

Following his graduation from college he worked for the Sales Organization of Vernon Motor Car Co., in Cincinnati from November, 1932, until August, 1934, when he left to join the Baldwin Piano Co., in New York City, which company he worked for until Sept, 1939. He then joined the New York and Pennsylvania Co., Inc., as Advertising Manager and Assistant to the first vice president in sales and sales promotion work until February, 1943, when he was commissioned in the USNR.

After attending Naval Indoctrination School at Quonset Pt., R.I., he was stationed at NAS, Lakehurst, and assigned to Blimp Squadron 12 and later to Blimp Hedron One. At Lakehurst he was assistant flight officer, assistant materiel officer, first lieutenant and parachute and safety officer. In August, 1944, he was detached to Blimp Headquarters Squadron 3, Detachment 31, at Santa Ana, Calif., at which field he was educational and training officer, first lieutenant, and administrative officer. In February, 1945, he was detached to CASU(F)-44, where he has successively been administrative officer and executive officer.

Lieut DANA has an intense interest in all phases of the CASU and has a thorough knowledge of the administration of all divisions and departments in the unit. His wide experience as an administrator in civilian life as well as in the naval reserve will prove of definite value to the CASU. His thoroughness combined with a deep sense of justice and fairness mark him as a capable executive officer.
