COMMANDING OFFICER'S MEMORANDUM

Subj: Training Program at Kaneohe Bay, Instructions concerning.

Encl: (A) List of Hands of Group A.
(B) List of Hands of Group B.
(C) List of Hands of Group C.

1. The men and Chief Petty Officers, as listed in Enclosures (A), (B) and (C), going to Kaneohe Bay, for training, will leave this Station at 1400 on the following days:

GROUP A - Friday, May 5, 1944.
GROUP B - Saturday, May 6, 1944.
GROUP C - Sunday, May 7, 1944.

2. The men shall carry no more gear than is absolutely necessary for a period of four (4) to seven (7) weeks. However, each man shall carry his mosquito net, the necessary frames for net, and his mattress. All infantry gear and other extra gear shall be tagged and stored in Hut #2, as there are no lockers available at Kaneohe Bay.

3. On arrival at Kaneohe Bay, each group will report to Chief Master at Arms LYONS at Barracks #11, for assignment to quarters.

4. The necessary mail arrangements for the men in these groups will be announced later.

5. At Kaneohe Bay, there shall be a daily muster of all CASU-44 men at 1715 each day.

6. Liberty, while there, shall be one day in six for all hands.
