Subj: Aviation Gasoline Supply, Administration of.

1. During the four weeks that this unit has been supplying aviation gasoline to planes, it has become evident that a unification of all aviation gas problems would clarify the aviation gas situation and facilitate the delivery of gas to planes.
2. At the present time seven organizations on this island are or have been engaged in aviation gas supply and delivery. In some cases four or five departments in each organization are working on the gas situation. It is felt that this condition has led to a detrimental lack of administrative control, for it is impossible for each organization, and each department of each organization, to be fully informed of the essential facts and conditions existing.
3. It is therefore recommended that a cognizant office be established at North Field to handle all feasible details of the gas situation, which office shall keep itself fully aware of the activities of other organizations on the Island that are engaged in receiving and distributing aviation gasoline, this office to remain in existence until there are adequate facilities for the storage of aviation gasoline in bulk ashore.
