A major development in the CASU's history occurred with the organization and establishment of the Flight Division. The CASU Pool at the present time contains eighteen (18) PB4Y-2's and eight (8) PV's. In addition there are seven (7) utility aircraft operated by the unit. The Flight Division is composed of three (3) Naval Aviators and eighteen (18) men whose duty it is to keep pool planes in operating condition for transfer to squadrons.

On 11 May 1945 the WIMU unit attached to CASU(F)-44 received a new Officer-in-Charge, namely Lt(jg) Robt. E. MILLER, S(06), USNR, 279973, who relieved Lt(jg) Leon C. LEONI, S(06), USNR, 143393.

The MAIRU unit also attached to CASU(F)-44, also had a change in Officers-in-Charge, when on 4 July 1945, Lt(jg) Raymond C. SWANSON, S(A), USNR, 286986, 4 relieved Lt(jg) James R. O'CONNOR, S(A), USNR, 207534.
